Understanding the new Performance Indicators

Progress 8:

- **Measures the average of how much progress pupils have made in 8 subjects** - including English (Language or Literature) and Maths (which are both counted twice), pupils' 3 best subjects from the English Baccalaureate (Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Double Science, Computer Science, Geography, History and Modern Foreign Languages) and pupils' best 3 other subjects
- **Pupils' progress is measured based on the scores they achieved in their KS2 tests**
- **Each GCSE cohort is measured against how well pupils nationally achieve in that specific year**
- **0.00 is the national average** and a school's Progress 8 score measures how far above or below the national average they have achieved

Attainment 8:

- **Measures the average of the total point score pupils have achieved across their 8 subjects counted for Progress 8**
- **Each GCSE grade is allocated a points score** - currently 8.5 for A*, 4 for C and 1 for G
- When pupils take new GCSEs (from 2017 in English and Maths and 2018/19 for all other subjects) each grade on the new 9-1 scale will be allocated a score from 9-1

Percentage of pupils who achieve C or above in English and Maths:

- In 2016 this measured the percentage of pupils gaining C grades and above in English (Language or Literature) and Maths
- From 2017 it will measure the percentage of pupils gaining a **'Strong' pass of 5** in English (Language or Literature) and Maths

Percentage of pupils achieving the English Baccalaureate:

- Percentage of pupils who achieved a C grade or above in English, Maths, 2 Sciences, a Language and either History or Geography
- From 2017 for English and Maths pupils will need to achieve a grade 5

Student destinations:

- **Percentage of students who continue in education or training, or move on to employment at the end of 16-19 study** - current figures based on 2014 leavers as measured a year after exam results
