MESSAGE FROM MR PANAYIOTOU

I would like to extend my warmest welcome to all of our new Year 7 students, parents and carers and I would like to commend them on how well they have all settled in. I am looking forward to seeing how they grow and develop over the next 5 years.

Thank you to all who have attended our Welcome Evenings for your specific year group, these have been invaluable for outlining our plans and have given the opportunity for parents to meet new form tutors. We are looking forward to the Year 8 and 9 Welcome Evenings taking place next week.

We have put many systems in place in order for us to be open and operational, a huge thank you must go to all of our students, staff and yourself for providing the feedback and support we have needed to enable this to happen. We will constantly review our systems and ensure that we adhere to guidelines set by Public Health England and DfE. If we need to make changes, we will communicate these to you as soon as they are available.

I would also like to take the opportunity to note and celebrate our excellent results from the Summer GCSEs of the class of 2020. The school's progress 8 score continues to improve, the class of 2020 achieved a progress 8 score of +0.64. This means on average, students achieved over half a grade better than their aspirational target grade. Considering the Government target is 0, this represents a phenomenal effort from staff and especially students. We are also extremely proud that 74% of our students secured a pass in English and Maths.

We will all be able to appreciate the challenges that faced the class of 2020, I am proud and delighted our students achieved the outcomes that they deserved and can go onto college or apprenticeships. A huge congratulations to all and we look forward to hearing about their successes in the near future.

We are planning to hold an open evening for current Year 6 students, which will allow appropriately grouped tours of the school. This will take place on Thursday 24th September at 15:30 – 20:00 with an Open Day taking place on Saturday 26th September between 9am and 13.15pm. These will offer opportunities to hear from myself and have tours of the school and the facilities we offer. I hope you can appreciate that we will have a limited opportunity to showcase our school, however there will be additional opportunities to explore our school online. More information will be sent to our feeder schools and will also be available on our website before the end of this week.

Finally, it has been a gigantic effort to get us all back to school and I am so proud of how all of our students have conducted themselves, with many new procedure we have had to put in place, they have done so very acceptingly and this is a real testament to our Worthing High School community. There is an extremely upsetting and highly graphic video, currently trending on the TikTok App, of an adult live-streaming themselves taking their own life.

Whilst TikTok have stated that they are doing their best to remove the video, it has been shared across all social media platforms thousands of times under fake captions which means the video is seen accidentally.

Some captions on TikTok are as trivial as "look at the pasta I cooked tonight" before the video then plays, so the young people can come across the video without even searching for it.

We cannot emphasise enough that this video is extremely distressing and we urge young people, parents and carers to avoid the TikTok App whilst this video is in such high circulation.
