MESSAGE FROM MR PANAYIOTOU

As we complete another week, I am delighted to see so many of our students settling into school and getting back to some normality.

The Prime Minister's announcement on Tuesday 22nd September highlighted that as a society we are all needing to adjust to living with Covid19 and the guidance for schools has not changed. We are very mindful of looking after our students and staff and will always take appropriate responses as directed by DfE and Public Health England. The NHS have launched a new track and trace app which is only for those aged 16+. Please download the app but remind your child that it is not age appropriate for them at this time.

Please can I remind you to follow the guidance if you or your child displays any symptoms and advise the school accordingly via <u>covid19@worthinghigh.net</u>.

The rule of 6 is also important out of school. Please can you reinforce this at home. When students leave school they should be returning home and not congregating in large numbers. We have had a number of local residents inform the school of gathering of students, congregating on Broadwater Green and this is something we are actively seeking to discourage with your support.

Can I also take the opportunity to remind parents and carers and all of our students regarding the use of social media relating to Covid19. It is and never will be appropriate to send out on a social media platform any information regarding a test result, positive or negative or speculation to whether a child is symptomatic or not. There have been a few situations where students discussed potential results and this is completely inappropriate and could be viewed as malicious in some extreme cases.

Finally, our Opening Evening event today and Saturday morning will provide a fantastic opportunity for prospective new entrants and their parents/carers to see our superb school and the opportunities that we are able to offer.

I am very proud of all our staff and students hard work and I wanted to thank all parents and carers for their continued support.

The NHS Immunisation Team are offering the HPV VACCINATION (Dose 1) for students in Year 9 that missed it in Year 8 or were unable to attend the pop up clinic in our car park during the summer holidays.

This will take place on Monday 5 October 2020.

An information letter/consent form and brochure will be issued to students during registration on **Monday 28 September 2020.**

Completed consent forms should be returned to form tutors or to the Main Office by **Thursday 1 October 2020** at the very latest. Failure to return the forms in time will mean your child may not be vaccinated. Apologies for the short turnaround.

FLU VACCINATION YEAR 7

For all parents of year 7 you should have received a letter direct from NHS advising you that your child is due to receive their flu vaccination. Parents and carers will need to provide consent before the vaccination can be administered, more information should be in your letter.

INTEREST FREE LOANS FOR THE URCHASE OF MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS & EQUIPMENT (England and Northern Ireland)

Interest-free loans are available for the purchase of musical instruments and equipment, to help ensure that more people across England and Northern Ireland can access instruments and learn to play.

The Take it Away Scheme works with music retailers to allow applicants to buy almost any musical instrument available, such as traditional instruments like violins, clarinets, guitars and pianos, contemporary equipment like synthesizers, drum machines and recording equipment, or musical accessories like cases.

The Scheme is backed by the Arts Council and makes loans of up to £5,000 to people in England aged up to 25 years, and up to £2,000 to all ages in Northern Ireland.

Applicants must have an annual income of £5,000 or more and applications can be made at any time.
