Dear Parents and Carers.

As we now start our first full day of remote learning, I wanted to write to you and thank you for your continued patience and support.

For many of us it will be very challenging, but we are now in a much better place to deliver our remote learning.

I am not complacent for one moment and know there will be times when technology or other IT issues may interrupt your child's learning. If this does occur we will endeavour to rectify the situation as soon as possible and all that I ask is that you are patient with us.

The government announcement yesterday regarding the cancellation of this summer's examinations has made it clear that Year 11 will be awarded grades based on teacher assessment and other school data. I must emphasise strongly the point that Year 11 must continue to work with the guidance and support of their teachers all the way to the end of the academic year. There is now even more of an opportunity for students to improve on past performances and their teachers will be able to see that evidence. It is therefore imperative that Year 11 continue with all their studies and follow advice from their teachers, as they are the ones who will be giving the assessment grade.

You will also be aware of the situation regarding BTEC and we have communicated to Year 10 and Year 11 our plans for them.

Keyworker and vulnerable students will have started at school today and had their Covid19 lateral flow test. As mentioned before we are and have always been supportive of keyworker and vulnerable families and if your circumstances should change, please do not hesitate to contact us by emailing covid19@worthinghigh.net

I also do not need to remind parents and carers that we have all now entered a national lockdown and all of us must adhere to the guidance and advice from the government, especially when it comes to being outside of our home environments and who we can meet. ACCESSING LIVE LESSONS

Teachers are not scheduling meetings, but running them as "meet now" sessions. When it comes to the start of form time or a lesson, students need to go to the relevant team and click on the "Join" button.

Lessons start at the following times:

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8:40 – tutor time

9:00 – period 1

10:05 – period 2

11:25 – period 3

12:30 – period 4

2:05 – period 5
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The Teams are all coded so students need to make sure they are in the right Team at the right time. The last couple of letters indicate which subject the Team is for le. Sc = Science, Ma = Maths, Sp = Spanish.

For tutor time, students need to go to their form group Team. This will be the Team that ends with the code B1, B2, H1, H2, S1, S2, T1, or T2 with the letter standing for Broadwater, Heene, Salvington or Tarring.
