## LETTER TO SHARE WITH PARENTS ON CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) TESTING

Public Health England has produced a <u>letter for schools and colleges to share with parents</u> which explains when a child requires a coronavirus (COVID-19) test and what the symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are.

The intention of the letter is to support parents and carers in identifying when their child needs to self-isolate as a result of displaying coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms and answer some of the questions parents may have around testing. We ask that you share this letter with parents and carers of children at your school or college.

### HPV VACCINATION - YEAR 9 - 5 OCTOBER 2020

Just as a reminder these are taking place on **Monday 5 October 2020**. The deadline for completed consent forms was today **Thursday 1 October 2020**. If you have not returned the form in time it may mean your child may not be vaccinated.

# **FLU VACCINATION YEAR 7**

All parents of year 7 should have received a letter direct from NHS advising you that your child is due to receive their flu vaccination. Parents and carers will need to provide consent before the vaccination can be administered, more information should be in your letter.

## PE KIT

Please can we ask for your support in ensuring students are wearing the correct PE kit to school on the days they have PE.

In particular, please be aware of the following:

- As it gets colder students will need to wear clothing over their polo shirts around school. Students are able to wear the ¼ zip training top in all year groups, or the WHS fleece in years 8-11. A blazer may also be worn and a water proof jacket should be brought to school on the day students have PE. Hooded tops are not part of the Worthing High School uniform and are not allowed to be worn at school.
- 2. Nike Pro shorts, or similar, are not allowed. These are not of a suitable length, they are tight and leave little modesty. We politely request that you ensure that your child has black shorts between thigh and knee length.
- 3. Leggings are not allowed for PE, they are only allowed for Performing Arts lessons.
- 4. Tracksuit trousers must be black and without any logos on.

## Students who do not have the correct kit will be sanctioned as per school policy.
