WHAT ARE THE ABAs?

The ABAs, or to give it its full name, The Sussex Coast Schools Amazing Book Awards, is a book award set up at the start of 2011 by a small group of school librarians from West Sussex. The group felt that secondary school students, particularly those in years nine and ten, were so often overlooked by those bigger book awards, which frequently aim themselves at students in lower years. The ABAs is a chance to let the students take control. Although we, with the help of the publishers and nominations from participating school librarians, create the long long list, the students choose the long list and then a shortlist of 5 and also vote for their favourites. There is no overall veto or "panel vote", the books chosen by the students are the winners.

The Shortlist will be announced on 3rd March, World Book Day. We will read all 5 books and then vote for our favourite. The winner will be announced at a fabulous presentation evening on *Friday 17th June*. Everyone is invited along to meet the authors.

At the moment we just need to vote for what books we would like to see on the shortlist. You don't have to have read them, just look at the blurb on the following pages and let us know the 5 you would like to put forward. Students from all participating schools do this and the ones with the most votes form the shortlisted titles.




THE WORLD BETWEEN US SARAH ANN JUCKES








GROW LUKE PALMER
