Can Luke save his family when all *they* want to do is save the planet?

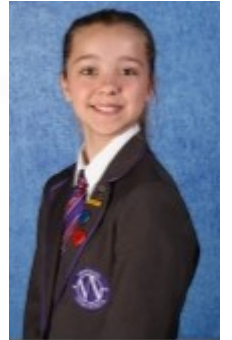
