2 Additional guidance

- Extremes of hairstyle are unacceptable. These include unnatural colours (for example extreme blonde/red/plum/purple tinted); two tone/dip dyed hair; shaved lines; shaved patterns or distinct sharp changes in length of hair are also not acceptable. Hair length must be No2 or above.
- It is only appropriate for discreet make-up to be worn to school. No coloured nails or acrylic nails are permissible or any nails that are of an inappropriate length. False eyelashes are not permitted. Eyeliner 'flicks' are also not permitted.
- Socks must be a plain black or grey colour without any logos.
- Students are not permitted to wear jewellery apart from one necklace which must be worn underneath their shirt. No rings, facial piercings (which includes tongue piercings) or bracelets are acceptable. One silver or gold stud of a maximum 4mm diameter per ear lobe is permitted. Any other item of ear jewellery including ear plugs and spacers are not acceptable items and will be confiscated. One "charity wrist band" is permissible.
- Students caught in contravention of the guidance, without good reason, will be either sent home to change, placed in internal exclusion or a request will be made to parents to bring appropriate uniform into school.
- If a student contravenes the uniform policy they will be isolated with their progress leader at break and lunchtime until the uniform is correct.
- If a student continues to refuse to cooperate, then sanctions may be applied which include internal exclusions, suspensions and may lead to a permanent exclusion.
- If individual students have a religious belief that conflicts with our policy please contact the school for further discussion.
