Next Tuesday is the second of our three Focus Days. This is a key date in the academic year as it provides students with the opportunity for enrichment activities. Year 7 will go out on a trip to the Weald and Downland Museum, Year 8 will focus on STEAM-related enrichment activities alongside student leadership and Year 10 will focus on careers, the work place and student leadership, ahead of potential prefect applications. For Year 9, it will be an opportunity to explore post 16 options and careers. We are delighted to welcome a number of former Worthing High students who will be

leading workshops on their experiences after Worthing High and into the world of work; these will range from Veterinary Science to Military engineering.
