Start of term arrangements

Students return on Monday 15 April and need to be in <u>tutor for the later time of 10:40am</u> where they will be registered and key information will be shared. Gates will be open from 10:25am, at which point students should make their way to their tutor base. Lesson will start as normal Period 3.

Year 11 exams and study leave

Written examinations will begin on Thursday 9 May; we are therefore starting study leave the following week from Monday 13 May. From this point Year 11s only need to come in for examinations. Their leavers assembly will take place from 11:30am on 10 May, after which they will be dismissed to go home.

Students should still come to school in full uniform and must be punctual. Before some exams, there will be revision sessions and information about these will be shared on Google Classroom.

There will be a staffed study room available for year 11, should they need a quiet place to study. The location of this room will also be shared via Google classroom.

English Bedrock Homework – Year 7 / Year 8

As part of the school's ongoing commitment to evidence-based literacy instruction, we are partnered with literacy improvement specialists **Bedrock Learning**. Built by former English teachers, Bedrock Learning is a digital literacy platform which offers learners a carefully sequenced and adaptive **vocabulary and grammar curriculum**. It exposes learners to new words and grammatical concepts through a rich diet of culturally valuable fiction and non-fiction, and its algorithm ensures that learning is personalised to your child, identifying and targeting gaps in knowledge.

When students engage regularly with the programme, this can be a transformative addition to our literacy offering, ensuring that our young people are equipped with the vocabulary and grammatical understanding they need to access the curriculum and express their ideas in every subject.

At WHS students in Year 7 and 8 are expected to carry out Bedrock Vocabulary lessons online for homework, to achieve a minimum of 20 points a week. Homework is set on a Monday and is due by the following Sunday. Teachers receive a report on Monday morning to track student engagement and progress. Those who do not achieve the required 20 points will be set an after school detention for the following Tuesday for 30 minutes. This is held in B3, a computer room, to allow them to catch up with their missing homework for English.
