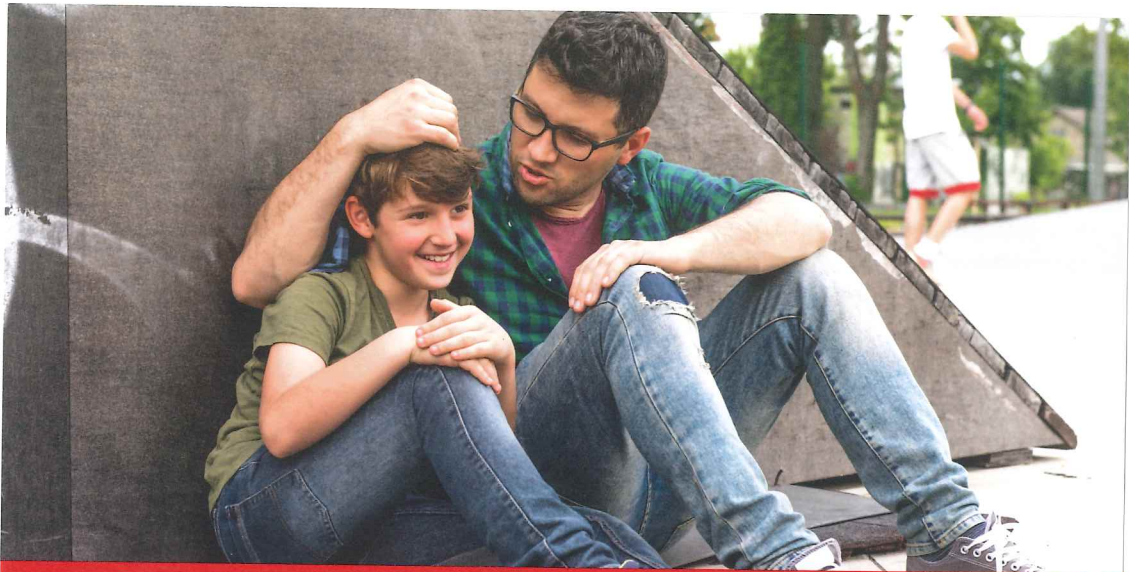
- When a parent living abroad sends their child to this country for education or health care.
